

Ovarian Hyperstimulation Syndrome (the Review of the Literature and Case Report)

Abstract

Ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome is a serious complication of ovarian stimulation occurring during the luteal phase or during the pregnancy. In this article the clinical case of ovarian syndrome hyperstimulating was described that arose in the patient at risk group as a result of hormonal stimulation of ovulation. Provides an overview of the literature on this disease with the classification, clinical manifestations, pathogenesis, diagnosis and treatment of this pathology.
