

State of Radiological Service in the Crimean Republic in 2013

Abstract

The article presents the analysis of statistical documents in 2013 in the Republic of Crimea, including the staffing of health facilities with radiologists, technicians, material and technical equipment, as well as the structure and number of radiological examinations. The analysis revealed a moderate shortage of staff (radiologist staffing – 73 %, technicians – 82 %) against the background of equipment staffing and its technical obsolescence. The relative number of radiological examinations considering equipment deficit is almost on the level as in the Russian Federation.
